Rom. 6:19: **presented** [NAB, NKJV, NRSV89, NRSV90], also **offer** [NIV11], **surrender** [NJB];

παριστάνετε, **paristánete**; *vb*: *pres act imperative 2nd pers pl* from παρίστημι:

Rom. 6:13: **present** [NAB, NKJV, NRSV89, NRSV90], also **give** [NJB], **offer** [NIV11]
